The Fixing Long-term Care Act is the governing document for longterm care in Ontario.

The foundation of the Act is the Residents' Bill of Rights.

"The fundamental principle to be applied in the interpretation of this Act and anything required or permitted under this Act is that a longterm care home is primarily the home of its residents and is to be operated so that it is a place where they may live with dignity and in security, safety and comfort and have their physical, psychological, social, spiritual and cultural needs adequately met."

The Act emphasizes the importance of progressive, residentcentered models of care. "44 (2)(b) to advance and share research on innovative and evidence-informed person-centered models of care."

The Glebe Centre in Ottawa is in the process of transforming to a resident-centered model of care. The Glebe was featured in a recent presentation, "A Journey of Change: From Institution to Home", sponsored by CARP and FCO.




