

From the desk of Christine Mills, Resident Services Coordinator Residents' Bill of Rights

In order to raise awareness of the Resident Bill of Rights, each month a number of rights will be shared in the newsletter.

The Ontario Residents' Bill of Rights is embedded in our provincial legislation, **Fixing Long-Term Care Act** (FLTCA), 2021, and accompanying Regulations (O. Reg. 246/22). There are 29 rights that are divided into 5 sections. If you think the rights are not being followed, contact the Home directly to speak with a member of the management team.

Section 1

RIGHT TO BE TREATED WITH RESPECT

- Every resident has the right to be treated with courtesy and respect and in a way that fully recognizes the resident's inherent dignity, worth and individuality, regardless of their race, ancestry, place of origin, colour, ethnic origin, citizenship, creed, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, age, marital status, family status or disability.
- Every resident has the right to have their lifestyle and choices respected.
- 3. Every resident has the right to have their participation in decision-making respected

Nursing Department Update:

- The next schedule for footcare nurse is as follow. August 3. 9, & 21
- Just a gentle reminder to clear items from the top of resident cupboard as this presents a safety risk staff reaching or items falling on residents or staff. This was an issue raised in our last quarterly Health and Safety Meeting.
- Another issuse identified is the cluttering of items on residents floors; this presents a challenge with cleaning the floors thoroughly in some cases, also reduce space for resident moving around in their room. If there are items not in use, (i.e. boxes with stored items) a suggestion is to remove it from the room.
- Finally, thanks to all families for their consistent support throughout the last months.



Infection Prevention & Control Updates

Re: COVID-19 Vaccine Boosters



The Ministry of Health has recommended that as of July 7th, 2023, further doses of COVID-19 Booster dose should be delayed until the fall. This is to ensure residents will meet the expected 6-month recommended interval from their last dose by fall. Receiving booster dose in the fall, heading into the respiratory illness season, will maximize protection against COVID-19 and related ill effects when peak circulation of the virus is expected.

Communication and request for consents will be sent out to residents and families ahead of any planned vaccination clinic.




