Hours of work:

- Usually 2 weekday shifts per week equal to approximately 13 hours per week
- May be required to work occasional weekends and holidays

Responsibilities:

- Perform regular maintenance duties throughout the building including the daily sweeping, mopping and weekly auto-scrubbing of hallways
- Deep cleaning of vents, cabinet tops and chrome polishing
- Garbage room clean out and cleaning of outdoor garbage containers
- Assist in snow removal at emergency exits and walkways
- Repair or replace lighting fixtures, bulbs and other minor electrical circuits
- Perform minor repairs to plumbing fixtures and piping
- Maintain proper chemical storage and labelling as per WHMIS regulations
- Be prepared, at all times, to take remedial action concerning building and employee security, emergency evacuation, safety and loss prevention
- Other duties as required to assist in building maintenance

Skills and Experience:

- Basic understanding of electrical, plumbing and HVAC systems
- Good understanding of hand tools, power tools and stationary power tools
- Experience with woodworking, painting and general construction is an asset
- Able to get along well with people especially seniors
- Flexible and able to prioritize

Effort:

- Requires bending, stretching, lifting of up to 50 lbs., climbing of stairs/ladders and long periods of time spent standing or walking
- Outdoor work may be required in all temperatures
