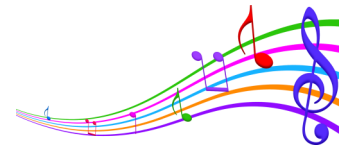

* **The Canadian Association for Long-term Care, (CALTC)** has presented its seven principle-based recommendations for national standards for long-term care. Please read these important recommendations.

“Canadian Association for Long-Term Care (CALTC)

FEBRUARY 2021- CANADA – The Canadian Association for Long Term Care (CALTC) is pleased to present its recommendations for resident-centred, principle-based national standards for long-term care.

CALTC’s recommendations rely on all levels of government, health system partners and the long-term care sector coming together to adopt principle-based standards that put residents, those who love them and those who care for them first.

CALTC’s recommendations fall under seven core principles that include:

- 1. Resident dignity, respect, safety and choice;**
- 2. Resident-centered and resident-directed care;**
- 3. Resident self-fulfillment in daily activities;**
- 4. Access to the appropriate level of care;**
- 5. Access to a home-like environment;**
- 6. Access to culturally appropriate care; and**
- 7. Access to dignity and comfort in dying**
